

## **Health Insurance for EU/SEE and non-EU citizens**

### **I. Conditions under which students from EU/SEE member states can benefit from medical services in Romania**

1. In case they are in need of emergency medical services, it is necessary for them to submit the European health insurance card (provided by the competent institution from the EU/SEE member state where they are insured) to the medical services provider in Romania (hospital etc.)
2. In case they want to benefit from all medical services according to the Romanian legislation, they have to submit the following documents at CAS Cluj:
  - Certificate of registration in Romania (provided by the General Immigration Office) or the document "CRDS Residence" provided by SPCLEP Cluj;
  - Portable S1 document, provided by the competent institution from the EU/SEE state member.

### **II. Documents that must be submitted by the foreign students-citizens from other states (which are not part of the EU/SEE member states) at CAS Cluj, regarding the obtaining of the healthcare right in Romania:**

- Valid document stating that they are students, provided by the educational institution from Romania – certificate;
- Document which certifies the right to temporarily stay in Romania – residence permit;
- Passport.
