Learn German at the coast!

The best place to learn German is in Germany! That is why Jade University is offering the successful "Seaside Summer Classes in German" for the 21st consecutive year at the campus in Wilhelmshaven.

Participants lives in Wilhelmshaven for a four-week period in which they improve their language skills in small groups overseen by qualified teachers. Each participant receives a certificate at the end of the course.

The course is particularly suited for those planning to study in Germany but also for anyone who would like to improve their German language skills.

Leisure Program

In addition to the morning language classes, our "Seaside Summer Classes in German" offers an extensive recreation program with for example:

- Welcome Barbecue
- Excursion to a major city
- Day Trip to the Amusement Park 'Heidepark'
- Mudflat Hiking
- Visit of the Beer Brewery in Jever
- Party of Culinary Specialties
- Farewell Party

Combined learning with activities and field trips

Five hours of lessons take place in small groups each morning. The afternoons are used to practice what was learned in the mornings. A placement test before the classes help to find the right course for each need.

It is our goal to train the participants' communicative skills: normal, everyday conversations are practiced so that pronunciation can be trained, listening skills improved and correct grammar used. Various cultural topics are worked out in projects or in presentations.

At the end of the course students will not only have deepened their knowledge of Germany and its culture, but also will have become much more competent with German and will have made many new friends!

Additional courses (optional)

Following courses may be offered at three or four afternoons:

- Intercultural Training
- German for Engineers
- Pronounciation Practice
- TestDaF Exam Preparation

ECTS

Six credits are given for successful completion of the course.

Course fee

The fee of the course is € 580.00 (Euro).

The course fee covers the costs of the lessons and excursions as well as many entrance fees. NOT included are any costs for accommodation and meals. Visiting students from our partner universities intending to register for an upcoming semester in the academic year of 2017/2018 will receive a 50% discount for the course

Accommodation in Wilhelmshaven

After the registration fee has been received, we will be glad to arrange accommodation in a youth hostel in the area. The charge for 4 weeks in a multi-bed dorm is \leq 420,00 per person (July 31st to August 25th 2017), including breakfast. The stay may be extended at an additional charge.

Other costs:

Each course participant is responsible for his/ her own meals for the four-week period. The costs for groceries are usually about 30-50 Euro per week. The canteen offers lunch at a good price.
