- The Faculty of Architecture and Urban planning will organize its activities for academic years and semesters according to the BCF decision after consultation with the students' representatives;

C1. DOCTORATE STUDIES

C1.1 Research/documentation activities will unfold through physical presence.

C1.2 1st semester, 1st academic year teaching activities will unfold online, according to the schedule established by the course holders with the faculties' BCF accord.

C2. POSTGRADUATE COURSES

C.2.1 COURSES - unfolded online;

C.2.2 APPLCATIONS (labs, projects) - unfolded onsite of online, after a schedule approved by the DECIDFR management, proposed by the program coordinator, in accordance with the postgraduate program's students and with approval from the faculty's dean's office in the spaces where the activity is unfolded.

D. COMMON MEASURES

D1. BCF at the proposition of course holders will establish the unfolding method of the seminars and projects (onsite and/or online) together with the students' representative;

D2. Practical applications (lab works) will unfold, ordinarily onsite;

D3. All teaching activities will unfold according to the schedule established by the BCF after consultation with the students;

D4. Housing in the student campuses will be made according to the regulation in effect, within the available seats, with abidance by the epidemiologic rules in effect, with priority for the students that have onsite activities according to the calendar above;



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D5. BCF at the proposition of the course holders will establish the teaching activities that allow modular scheduling;

D6. Students which originate from red zones (according to the DSP website) will mandatorily show a negative SARS-CoV2 test at their arrival/return at TUCN, issued with a maximum of 72 hours before their presence in the teaching/housing spaces of the university;

D7. Course, seminar, lab and pedagogical practice teaching activities framed by DSPP (Baia Mare and Cluj-Napoca) will unfold online, for all academic years, bachelor and master level, both semesters;

D8. Teaching staff with severe health problems or which have such relatives can hold all activities online under an affidavit forwarded to the BCF;

D9. Students with severe health problems or which have such relatives can hold all activities online, applications included, under an affidavit forwarded to the BCF. The teaching staff will hold online course recovery for the practical activities with these students, in the frame of the consultations schedule;

D10. Teaching staff have the option of choosing their platform for holding the online teaching activities with recording of the held activity.

E. SUSPENSION TERMS FOR THE ONSITE TEACHING ACTIVITIES

According to the Ministry of Education and Research and Ministry of Health Common Order, published in O.J. from 01.09.2020, teaching activities unfolded onsite can be suspended in the following circumstances:

E1. Students getting sick from COVID-19:

E1.1. One case in one student group – onsite teaching activities are suspended for 14 days, turning into online teaching activities for that respective group, for the student groups which had joint teaching activities with that group, for the teaching staff which held activities with the students from that group, as well as for all the student groups which those teaching staff interacted with.

E1.2. Three concomitant cases (within 14 days from the first case) in separate groups of the same faculty – onsite teaching activities are suspended for 14 days, turning into inline activities for the whole faculty. The suspension applies to doctoral studies as well.

E1.3. Three concomitant faculties (within 14 days from the first case) found in situation 1.2 – onsite teaching activities are suspended for 14 days, turning into online activities for the whole university. The suspension applies to doctoral studies as well.



E2. Teaching staff getting sick from COVID-19:

E2.1. Teaching activities with a single student group – all onsite teaching activities are suspended for 14 days, turning into online activities for that teaching staff and that group. Other teaching staff which came in contact with the positive-tested teaching staff will also hold their teaching activities online.

E2.2. Teaching activities with multiple student groups – all onsite teaching activities are suspended for 14 days, turning into online activities for that teaching staff and those groups. Other teaching staff which came in contact with the positive-tested teaching staff will also hold their teaching activities online. If the number of teaching staff which came in contact is high, the whole faculty or, by case the whole university will suspend the onsite teaching activities, turning those into online activities.

Any change to this teaching activities structure, as a result of the pandemic evolution and/or the issue of new legal regulations, will be submitted to the approval of the TUCN Senate.
