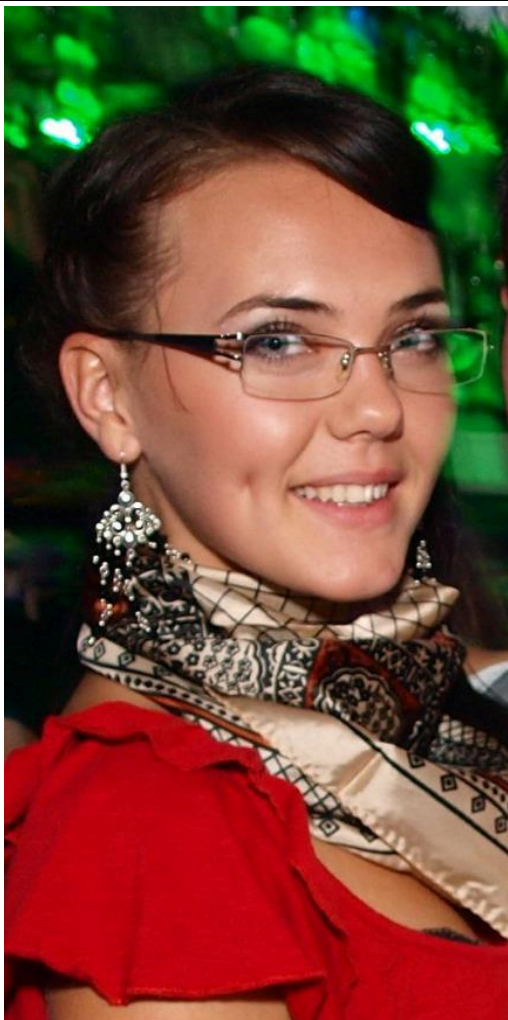

**Turkey**



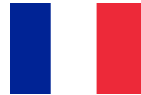
