

Health Insurance for EU/EEA and non-EU Citizens

I. Conditions under which students from EU/EEA may receive medical services in Romania

1. In case you need urgent medical treatment, it's necessary to present a European health insurance card (issued by the competent institution of the member state EU/EEA where you are insured) to the provider of the medical services (hospitals, specialist outpatient clinic, etc.)
2. In case you want to get all the benefits of the medical services, according to legislation Romania, you need to present to CAS Cluj these documents:
 - Registration certificate in Romania (issued by the General Inspectorate of Immigration) or the residence CRDS issued by SPCLEP Cluj.
 - A portable document S1 issued by competent institution of the member state EU/SEE.

II. The documents that must be presented by foreign citizens - students from other states (which are not part of EU/EEA member states) to CAS Cluj in order to have the right to the medical assistance in Romania:

- A valid document in which it states that you are student, issued by an educational institution in Romania – Student Certificate (*Adeverință*¹).
- A document clarifying the right of temporary residence in Romania- residence permit.
- Passport.
