## Useful Information for Non-EU Full Time Students

## PRIOR TO YOUR ARRIVAL IN CLUJ-NAPOCA

- Check the room allocation list (see IRO's web page -> Students Housing -> Timetable) in case you registered for a place in the dorm. Announce your arrival outside working hours in time at IRO, or look for a place to stay until the next work day;
- Register for a local buddy (see IRO's Useful Information web page);
- Pay the tuition fee for the first academic year (see IRO's **Useful Information** web page) via bank transfer or at the TUCN tax office (self-funded students only);
- Bring the original documents submitted during your admission process + the Letter of Acceptance to Studies (+ bank receipt - self-funded students only) to the International Relations Office (online appointment required);
- Participate in our Welcome Day Event dedicated to our international students!

#### DURING THE ACADEMIC YEAR

- Keep in touch with your faculty assigned secretaries for additional information;
- Register with the General Inspectorate for Immigration within the first 30 days
  of your arrival at 51-53 Alexandru Vaida Voievod Street, aka Iulius Mall;
- Submit your Residence Permit at the Secretariat of the Faculty and at IRO;
- Ask for the suitable version of the accommodation contract (available in English and Romanian), read it and sign it;
- Ask for the suitable **student contracts** (available in English, French and Romanian at the Secretariat of the Faculty), **read them** and sign them;
- Pick up your student card and train card from the Secretariat of the Faculty (issued within about two weeks from your first meeting with the International Relation Office).

#### ACCOMMODATION IN THE TUCN DORMS

- Pay your accommodation fee in due time monthly (including for the last month of stay);
- Do not leave the dorm for more than two weeks at a time (check the contract);
- Inform the dorm manager of your intention to leave 3 days prior to your departure;
- Be advised that TUCN dorms are closing for a month during the summer holiday.

- When you need English translations of the certificates issued by the structures of TUCN for the bank, embassy and army;
- Whenever you need guidance.
