

- If you want to study any of these levels in English or French, you have to upload the appropriate certificate that proves your knowledge about the corresponding language.

## Short presentation

The Technical University of Cluj-Napoca (TUCN) organizes a Preparatory year of Romanian Language for the international students according to the accreditation granted by the Romanian Agency for Quality Assurance in Higher Education, Order of the Ministry of National Education published in the Official Journal of Romania No. 680/06.08.2018.

This program is compulsory for the international students who wish to access programs of studies offered exclusively in Romanian Language.

The courses are organized within the Department of Modern Languages and Communication of the university and are taught by specialist professors in teaching the Romanian language as a foreign language. The admission to this program is organized according to the present legislation and according to the specific methodologies and procedures of the TUCN. The actual admission may differ according to different types of citizenship and permanent residence (EU/non-EU).

The course lasts one academic year, and it is split in 2 semesters (60 ECTS) and engages a full training for achieving competences in the field of Romanian language, culture and civilization, as well as specific knowledge in the fields of engineering, applied sciences (mathematics and nature sciences), biology and biomedical sciences. According to the curriculum, the Preparatory year of Romanian Language proposes the following subjects:

\* 4<sup>th</sup> of February - 13<sup>th</sup> of July - **STEP 1** - Online application

\* 7<sup>th</sup> of February - 21<sup>th</sup> of July - **STEP 2** - Issuance of the Pre-enrolment Consent/Refusal

\* 19<sup>th</sup> of April - 25<sup>th</sup> of July - Successful applications being forwarded to the Ministry of Education and Research

\* July - September - **STEP 3** - Issuance of the official response by the Ministry of Education

\* 27<sup>th</sup> of September - 15<sup>th</sup> of October - **STEP 4** - Presenting the complete set of original documents and enrolment

NOTES regarding the above timeline:

- The average file processing time at TUCN is a fortnight. Mandatory condition: **the file must be complete. An incomplete file will not be processed**, the file processing fee will not be refunded, and the candidate will receive a refusal from the university
- PhD degree seeking candidates must request and obtain a Pre-enrolment consent from a PhD supervisor prior to uploading the file in the online application. The list of PhD supervisors and their contact details are available here.
- The aptitude test for **Architecture** will take place at a date and in a manner agreed by the Faculty of Architecture and Urban Planning
- The aptitude test for Arts (BA only) will take place at a date and in a manner agreed by the Faculty of Humanities.

In “Admission Calendar” you can see the beginning and end of admission period, the dates are UPDATED every year.

## Admission Steps

### Step 1 - Online application

The candidate must complete the **application form**, pay the file processing fee (**show / hide**) and submit online all the required documents **here**.

The candidate's file must contain the following documents:

- ↳ Birth certificate – copy and legalized translation;
- ↳ Copy of the ID which states the permanent residence in a foreign country;
- ↳ Copy of the passport;
- ↳ The Application for the issuance of the letter of acceptance to studies – it **MUST** be filled in with capital letters and all fields are mandatory;
- ↳ High School Graduation Diploma or its equivalent – copy and legalized translation, **authenticated (show / hide)** by the authorities in the issuing country;

#### Authentication is defined by the ministry as follows:

- \* Diplomas issued in countries which are not parties to the Hague Apostille Convention shall be authenticated or accompanied by an authentication certificate from by the competent authorities in the issuing countries;
- \* Legalization/Authentication is done by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs from the issuing country, the Embassy/Consular Office of Romania in the issuing country and the Romanian Ministry of Foreign Affairs or by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in the issuing country, the issuing country's Embassy/Consular Office in Romania and the Romanian Ministry of Foreign Affairs; for countries where Romania does not have a diplomatic mission or countries which do not have diplomatic missions in Romania, the study documents shall be legalized by the Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs from the issuing country;
- \* Legalization/Authentication exemption is allowed under the law of an international treaty to which Romania is party or on a reciprocity basis.

- ↳ Bachelor's Degree Diploma or its equivalent – copy and legalized translation, **authenticated** by the authorities in the issuing country **(if applicable)**;
- ↳ Master's Degree Diploma or its equivalent – copy and legalized translation, **authenticated** by the authorities in the issuing country **(if applicable)**;

In “Admission Steps” you’ll see all the 4 steps of admission. **Step 1** is “Online application” where you fill in the application form and upload the necessary documents.(we’ll see how..). Read carefully the list of the documents that you have to upload.

If you click “(show/hide)” a small window appears where you get better understanding of what an **authenticated** document is.

“if applicable” simply means “if you have”, for example, if you are applying for preparatory year and you **don't have** a degree yet, then you don't have to upload anything regarding Bachelor's Degree(or Master's Degree), **on the other hand**, if you are applying for preparatory year and you **have** Bachelor's Degree(let's say you're going to do your Master's), you have to upload your Bachelor's Diploma.(the same for PhD level).

## Steps of uploading a document

The asterisk (\*) means that it is **obligatory** to upload the document, if there is no asterisk, then it is optional.


**Don't forget** that the files you upload **must be** in the **pdf** or **jpg** format.





- **Identification Document(ID)** – means your ID(or **national** passport) which you use inside your country. Here also, do the same steps: 1. Choose file, 2. choose ID, 3. Click Open.




- **Passport** – means **international** Passport which you use to travel abroad(outside your country). Here also, do the same steps: 1. Choose file, 2. choose Passport, 3. Click Open.




- High School Diploma

Here also, do the same steps: 1. Choose file, 2. choose High\_School\_Diploma, 3. Click Open.



These fields are obligatory for those who already have Bachelor's (maybe also) Master's Degree.

- **Transcript of Records** – means the record(list) of the marks from all subjects that you had in the last 3 or 4 years of high school.  
Here also, do the same steps: 1. Choose file, 2. choose Transcript, 3. Click Open.




These fields are obligatory for those who already have Bachelor's (maybe also) Master's Degree.

- Medical Certificate


Here also, do the same steps: 1. Choose file, 2. choose Medical, 3. Click Open.

1. Original documents issued in the signatory countries of The Hague Convention are to be authenticated with The Hague Apostille by Competent Authorities designated by the government of a state which is party to the convention.
